Global Humanitarian Consultant and Adviser

As well as ongoing humanitarian consultancy work, during 2019, Chris was also the Global Humanitarian Adviser (GHA) to three agencies². Humanitarian work includes engagement in both natural hazards/disasters, as well as conflict-related complex emergencies³. Chris is now currently exploring new GHA opportunities throughout 2020. The intended outcome of a GHA role is: 'To utilise Chris' experience, skills and insights to assist the client agency in question to become more proficient in planning, implementing and evaluating humanitarian initiatives in the field'.

Chris' GHA work covers three main complementary areas, namely:

- Humanitarian initiatives across the Normal/Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR), Emergency Response, and Recovery Stages of the Disaster Risk Management Cycle (DRMC)⁴. These could include input into strategic planning, reports, reviews & evaluations
