### Community Engagement and Training Adviser (CETA)

Chris is currently exploring new opportunities to work both as a Community Engagement and Training Adviser (CETA), as well as Global Humanitarian Adviser (GHA)<sup>1</sup> throughout 2020. The intended outcome of a CETA role is:

‘To utilise Chris’ experience, skills and insights to assist the client agency in question to become more proficient in community engagement with their partners in the field, as well as offering relevant, high quality, training and capacity building services’.

Chris’ CETA work covers three main complementary areas, namely:

- Development of genuine community engagement initiatives based on mutual trust, respect and communication. Participatory techniques such as the Ten Seed Technique (TST) ranking tool will be utilised, to allow an opportunity to brainstorm community strengths and challenges. With regards the latter challenges, there will then be opportunities to together work through causes, effects, and possible solutions
- Community based training, particularly around the following two topics:
